ICPD beyond 2014

UN General Assembly Resolution 65/234:

- Extended the ICPD
- Called for:
 - a comprehensive review of progress
 - identification of remaining challenges
 - recommendations for moving forward
- Integration population in global processes



ICPD beyond 2014 – desired outcomes

- Renewal of political support for the ICPD Programme of Action
- Priorities for future implementation
- No roll back
- Full integration into the post-2015 development agenda
- An agenda owned by all



Why is this important?

A strong actionoriented, rightsbased outcome will support:




ICPD and Post-2015




ICPD review: timeline
