


MOANA: IDENTITY (GOD's Grace)




Inter-connectedness (Flowing to each other/ Together flow)

Concrete examples from my own context (Anglican in American Samoa, Samoa, Tonga, Fiji and Polynesians in New Zealand)

- <u>Identity:</u> safety of the space (non-violent leadership beginning from leaders)
- **Community:** GOD One Moana/Many Oceans
- Vitality/Where life lies (Young people are placed at the centre of all Diocesan activities, Young people included in all decision-making bodies of the Church)
- Gender balance 50-50 on all decision making bodies
- Anglicare House of Sarah, Resettlement of Landless People
- Hibiscus Carnival Suva City: Suva parishes active participation and impact. Organization of major Youth event
- Methodology: Talanoa pathway
 (Community/Communities talk Act together)
